GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTERS

International Congress of Nutrition, 4-9 October 2009, Bangkok, Thailand

Each poster will be displayed on a designated date between 5-9 October 2009 inside Exhibition Hall 102, 1st Floor, BITEC. Authors are kindly requested to be available during the allotted date and time to answer questions regarding their posters.

POSTER DEVELOPMENT



- Actual usable space for each poster board is 1.80 m (height/vertical) by 0.80m (width/horizontal).
- Posters should be readable by delegates from five feet away.
- A label indicating the abstract title, authors and their affiliations must be placed at the top of the poster.
- The message should be clear and understandable without oral explanation. Include in the display a short and comprehensive review of the basic items from the study. You may divide the text into several clear sections, including: title, authors, introduction, case reports/material/ methods,

figures/graphs/photos, results, conclusions and major references.

- A label listing the funding source(s) must be displayed in the lower right corner of the poster.

POSTER SET-UP & DISMANTLING

- Posters will be displayed on a **daily basis** and must be dismantled at the close of the conference session EVERY DAY. Set-up and dismantling dates and times are as follows:

For display on	Set-up Date / Time	Dismantling Date / Time

6 October	5 October / 17:00-21:00 hrs.	6 October / 17:00-21:00 hrs.

8 October	7 October / 17:00-21:00 hrs.	8 October / 17:00-21:00 hrs.

- Poster numbers will be affixed to the poster boards. Authors will be able to identify their assigned poster board by locating their poster numbers in a list to be posted on-site.
- Temporary staff will be available at the poster area during the set-up time to assist authors in setting up and dismantling their posters.
- Double-adhesive tapes, scissors, cutters, and other necessary materials will be supplied.
- DO NOT write or paint on the poster boards. DO NOT use nails, push pins, screws, or any tools that will puncture the poster boards.
- Posters remaining after 21.00 hrs. every day will be removed.
- The 19th International Congress of Nutrition organizers do not accept responsibility for displayed poster materials.
